Baby Rescue PROJECT 19

For Project 19 - Baby Rescue, our givers sponsored a baby rescue program that involved a dropbox, sincere and helpful caretakers, and an adoption program to place abandoned infants in loving homes throughout 2019-2020.

eMite partnered for the third time with Impact Africa, a Christian nonprofit that reaches out to the poor communities around Johannesburg, South Africa, through service and education. They provide

humanitarian assistance such as job training, prenatal care for pregnant women, baby rescue, and school development to allow cost-effective education.

This project helped prevent child abandonment, support desperate young mothers, and ensure children's bright future through life-long family care. During the time eMite sponsored the Impact Baby Rescue Program, 21 babies were rescued off the streets. ■

Well of Hope PROJECT 20

For Project 20 - Well of Hope, our givers sponsored a well that brought clean water to 312 people in the rural village of Gola Chefe, Ethiopia. eMite partnered with Lifewater, a top-rated Christian organization dedicated to ending the global water and sanitation crisis.

Safe water alone cannot prevent water-related illnesses; a complete WASH (water access, sanitation,

hygiene) strategy is critical for creating lasting change. Simple things like a hand washing station can cut down the risk of water-related illnesses for every child.

Project 20 provided clean water, education on preventing diseases, and maintaining healthy households. Ultimately it provided new hope and a transformation to hundreds of lives. ■

Bed For Every Head

PROJECT 21

For Project 21 - Bed for Every Head, our givers sponsored new bunk beds & mattresses for 200 children at Acres of Hope orphanage.

eMite partnered with Acres of Hope, an organization that offers a hope-filled future for orphans and vulnerable children in a Christ-centered community by equipping them with basic needs such as food, shelter, medical care, and education.

Many children were sharing twin beds or sleeping on the ground leading to sleep deprivation. They now have a sturdy frame and soft mattress to rest their heads every night. Good sleep promotes growth, supports a healthier heart, and helps strengthen the immune system against germs. It also increases children's attention span and improves their ability to learn. ■

Covered With Care PROJECT 22

For Project 22 - Covered with Care, eMite donated 1,000 face masks to the Charlotte-Mecklenburg School System volunteers who distribute breakfast and lunch to low-income families every day. These volunteers are exposed daily to the COVID-19, and a mask is part of their mandatory safety equipment.

Even though the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Board of Educations decided to close schools amid Covid-19,

the Child Nutrition Services implemented an emergency program and set up nearly 70 mobile distribution sites.

Through Project 22, you helped provide COVID Warriors who meet the daily needs of low-income families with a safe working environment. ■

Build A Bathroom PROJECT 23

For Project 23 - Build a Bathroom, our givers sponsored a new bathroom for 190 students and ten teachers at Bentum Dreambuilder's School in Ghana. eMite partnered with Sub-Saharan Education Project, an organization supporting women and children's welfare by investing in local resources and providing education for extreme poverty individuals.

Proper sanitation facilities on school grounds are imperative for students and teachers. These facilities will promote consistent attendance, especially among school-age girls. With a new bathroom facility, the children and teachers have a dignified place to study with access to guaranteed essential services. ■

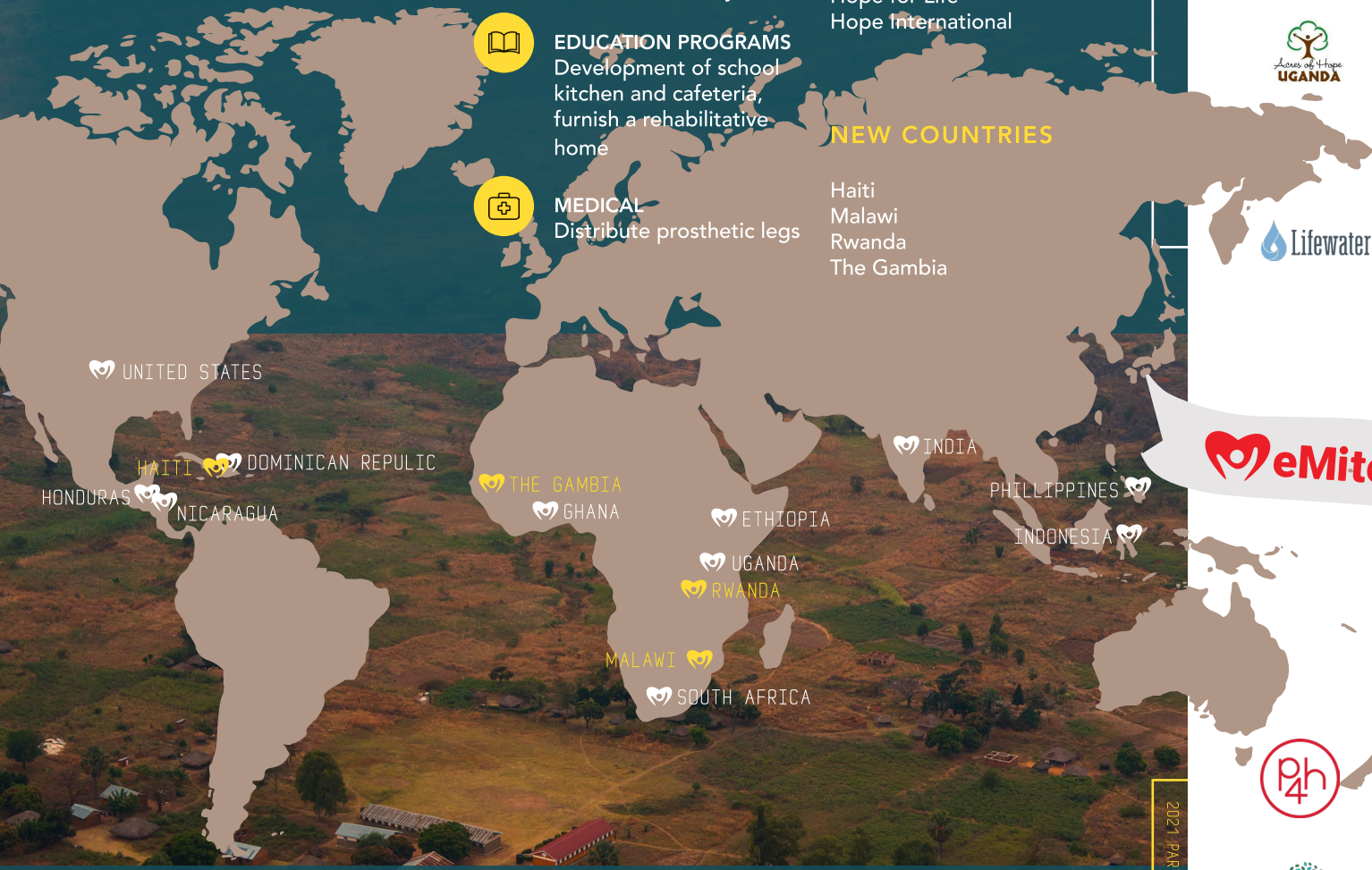
