With our efforts from Project 32 and 36, we helped 1,200 families in Timor get their lives back on track after the effects of that natural disaster.

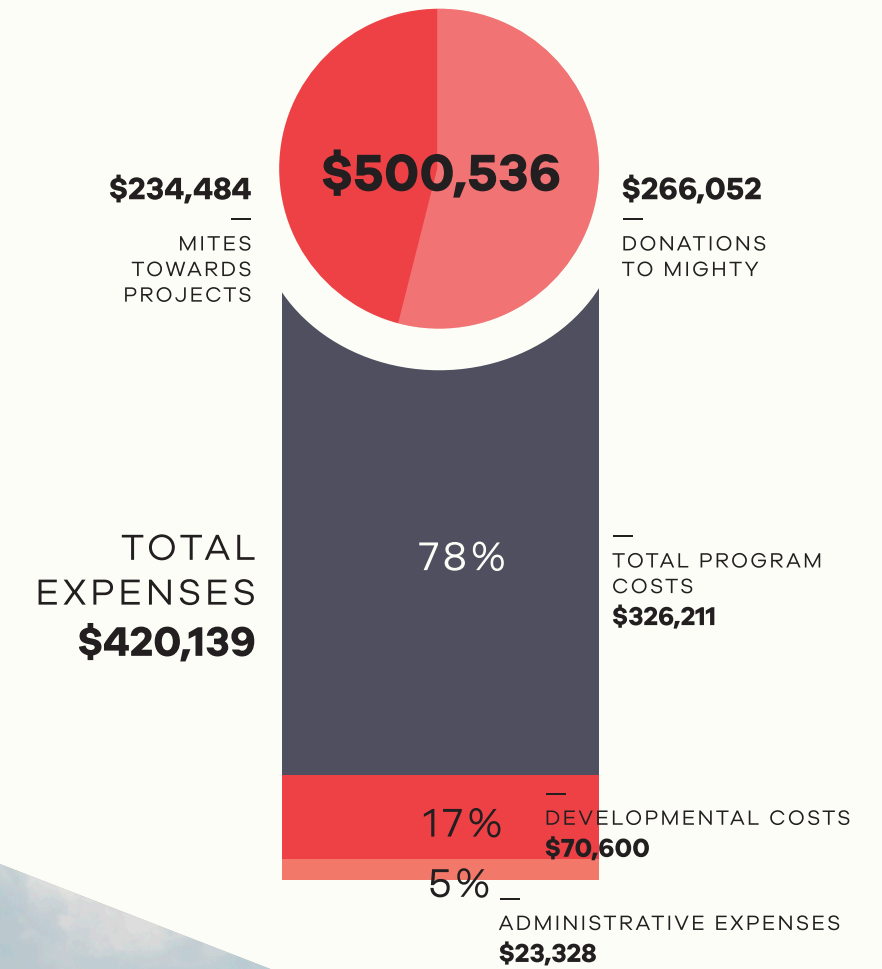
